Dear President Bush,

I understand that Congress is resurrecting a bill called the Employment Non Discrimination Act, EDNA, and will try to attach it to an appropriations bill. This act would place people's private sexual lives into public law with punishment for us who oppose it.

This proposal has been crafted by men who have sex with men, MSM and women who have sex with women, WSW, and who have organized to introduce their life style as lawful in the public forum.

If you were make this a law, it would impose upon all the nation the MSM and WSW propaganda that their sexual behavior is normal, inborn, unchangeable, and necessary for happiness and fulfillment. It would penalize churches, pastors, teachers, professors, scientists, psychologists and others who do not believe this propaganda.
